

Physical Development

- Weekly sessions PE - Core Real PE - Foundation Unit 3 Cognitive Skills/Dynamic Balance/Static Balance
- Independently dressing and undressing themselves (fastening buttons and zips, putting on coats/wellies/jumpers/outdoor 'wetsuits')
- Activities to develop fine motor skills and pencil control - tracing, dough gym, tweezers, pegs, jigsaws
- Outdoor activities - mud kitchen, sand play, message centre, construction activities
- Talking and writing about ways to stay healthy, including handwashing, healthy food choices, rest and exercise - planning own routines
- Transport and store equipment safely and appropriately (outdoor tidying routines)

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Adult focus during continuous provision to support children in making choices, planning what they are going to do and tidying away the resources they have used
- Reinforce school/class rules and explain - refer to it as much as possible during the day
- Focus on sharing and turn taking, emphasising the importance of treating each other how we would like to be treated - games, circle and story time activities
- Playing co-operatively with each other and teaching the children to resolve conflicts and find compromises
- Encouraging children to ask for adult support if they feel unhappy or left out of a friendship group.

Communication and Language

- Join in with familiar songs and rhymes (Nursery Rhymes)
- To join in when conversation interests them (especially at snack table), making their meaning clear
- To ask and answer questions about stories and topics shared with class or group
- Learn new words rapidly and use them in communicating about matters which interest them
- Join in with repeated refrains and anticipated key events in familiar stories
- To listen carefully and follow instructions in the correct order (take off your coat and put your water bottle in the tray)
- Show understanding of prepositions such as 'under', 'on top' and 'behind'
- To begin to use more complex sentences when speaking, using conjunctions (because, but, and)
- Use language to imagine and recreate roles and experiences in play situations - traditional tales

Mathematics

NCTEM/White Rose/Numberblocks

- Counting to 20 forwards and backwards, 1s, 2s and 5s,
- Recognising numbers to 10
- Number formation of numerals 0-9
- Ordering numbers to 10 and then 20
- Join in with number rhymes and songs
- Match number and quantity correctly
- Make comparison between quantities using language more/less
- Recognise variation in size and weight
- Recognise various coins and understand their value (1p, 2p, 5p)
- More/less than a given number
- Simple addition and subtraction using language more/less

Expressive Arts and Design

- Experimenting with the sounds of different instruments and listening to music from other countries, especially China
- Continue to use a variety of media e.g. chalks, paints, pastels
- Use tools and techniques competently and appropriately
- Continue to build a repertoire of songs and performing a dragon dance
- Engage in imaginative role play based on first-hand experiences - empty boxes from frozen foods would be appreciated!
- Creating paper lanterns and Winter collages using cotton wool/silver foil, etc
