### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Adult focus during continuous provision to support children in making choices, planning what they are going to do and tidying away the resources they have used
- Making mistakes encouraging a positive attitude to making mistakes as it can be the best way to learn.
- Learning about how to stay safe outside of school
- Focus on sharing and turn taking, emphasising the importance of treating each other how we would like to be treated - games, circle and story time activities
- Playing co-operatively with each other and teaching the children to resolve conflicts and find compromises
- Ginger Bear activities to encourage turn-taking, empathy and speaking in a small group.
- Playing co-operatively with others and teaching the children to resolve conflicts and find compromises.

### Communication and Language

- Joining in with games, songs and rhymes
- Listening to visitor sessions and asking questions about what they have heard
- Answering questions about stories they have read and heard
- To retell events from stories in the correct order.
- Using talk to express themselves at snack time, talking about events from their past and their home life
- Sharing their knowledge of our topic and making links to their own experiences
- To practise speaking in full sentences when answering questions about stories they have read and heard.

### Mathematics

NCTEM/White Rose/Numberblocks

- Counting to 20 forwards and backwards, 1s, 2s and 5s,
- Recognising and ordering numbers to 20
- Correct formation of numerals 0-9 (all start at top)
- Join in with number rhymes and songs
- Match number and quantity correctly
- Make comparison between quantities using language more/less
- Recognise variation in size, length, capacity, weight.
- Recognise various coins and understand their value (1p, 2p, 5p)
- Simple addition and subtraction using language more/less
- Making simple patterns.
- Exploring complex patterns.
- Adding by counting on.
- Taking away by counting back.
- Doubling /Halving /Sharing.
